If Bridgebit learns that a child under the age of 13 has submitted Personal Information (defined below) online without parental consent, we will take all reasonable measures to delete the information as soon as possible and to not use such information for any purpose, except where necessary to protect the safety of the child or others as required or allowed by law. 1. Introduction

Thanks for choosing Automotive Finance Corporation!

At Bridgebit, we want to give you the best possible experience to ensure that you enjoy our service. To do this we need to understand your usage habits so we can deliver an exceptional and personalized service specifically for you. Your privacy and the security of your personal data is, and will always be, enormously important to us. So, we want to transparently explain how and why we gather, store, share and use your personal data - as well as outline the controls and choices you have around when and how you choose to share your personal data.

That is our objective, and this Privacy Policy ("Policy") will explain exactly what we mean in further detail below.

2. About this Policy

This Policy sets out the essential details relating to your personal data relationship with Bridgebit Software Inc. The Policy applies to all Bridgebit services and any associated services (referred to as the Bridgebit Service').

From time to time, we may develop new or offer additional services. If the introduction of these new or additional services results in any material change to the way we collect or process your personal data we will provide you with more information or additional terms or policies. Unless stated otherwise when we introduce these new or additional services, they will be subject to this Policy.

The aim of this Policy is to:

- 1. Ensure that you understand what personal data we collect about you, the reasons why we collect and use it, and who we share it with;
- 2. Explain the way we use the personal data that you share with us in order to give you a great experience when you are using the Bridgebit Service; and
- 3. Explain your rights and choices in relation to the personal data we collect and process about you and how we will protect your privacy.

We hope this helps you to understand our privacy commitments to you. If you do not agree with the content of this Policy, then please remember it is your choice whether you want to use the Bridgebit Service.

3. Your rights and your preferences: Giving you choice

and control

The General Data Protection Regulation or "GDPR" gives certain rights to individuals in relation to their personal data. 4. Personal data we collect from you

Depending on the type of Bridgebit Service plan you sign up for, this may include your username, email address, phone number, birth date, gender, street address, and country. Some of the personal data we will ask you to provide is required in order to create your account. You also have the option to provide us with additional personal data in order to make your account more personalized. The exact personal data we will collect depends on the type of Bridgebit Service plan you sign up for, how you create an account, and whether you use third party services (such as LinkedIn) to sign up and use the Bridgebit Service. If you use a third party service to create an account, we will receive personal data via that third party service but only when you have consented to that third party service sharing your personal data with us. Please note that the available plans and sign-up options may differ by country.

- device attributes of devices on your wifi network that are available to connect to the Bridgebit Service (such as speakers);
 your non-precise location, which may be derived or inferred from certain technical data (e.g., your IP address, language setting of your device, or payment currency), to comply with geographic requirements in our licensing agreements, and deliver personalized content and advertising to you; and
 - motion-generated or orientation-generated mobile sensor data (e.g. accelerometer or gyroscope) required for the purposes of providing specific features of the Bridgebit Service to you.

Plan Verification Data

For users of certain plans like the Premium Plan and Enterprise Plan, we may use a third party mapping application (such as Google Maps) and/or your device's location service to help you verify your address. This data is collected for the sole purpose of verifying eligibility for the Premium Plan and Enterprise Plan and is not used for advertising or any other purpose.

The table below describes personal data that you choose to give us that enables us to provide you with additional features/functionality

Information We Collect

We collect the following information, including:

- Personal Information You Share with Us: "Personal Information" is information that can personally identify you, such as your name, email address and telephone number. We maintain one or more databases to store your Personal Information and may retain it as reasonably required to serve you and operate the Service. Personal Information that we collect depends on how you use the Service. Providing your Personal Information to us is your choice. If you choose not to provide us with certain Personal Information, you may not be able to take advantage of certain features of the Service; and
- Information We Collect Automatically: When you visit the Service, we may automatically collect identifier and other technical information, such as your browser information, operating system information, device information, TCP-IP address and the date, time, length of stay and specific pages accessed during your visits to the Service ("Online Information").

Online Identification Tools

Like many website providers, we use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and provide a better web experience. Your IP address is used to help identify you and your shopping cart and gather Online Information.

We use web beacons (a.k.a. clear GIFs, web bugs or pixel tags) to personalize your experience of the Service and to generate information about Service traffic and trends. Web beacons collect Online Information, such as the type of browser that you use and

How Your Personal Information is Used, Processed and Disclosed

Except as specified in this Privacy Policy, Company does not rent, sell, trade or disclose your Personal Information to third parties without your prior consent. Company may, however, use, process and disclose Personal Information to:

- send information to customers about orders;
- fulfill your orders;
- process and collect your payments;
- administer "Company Rewards" and other customer loyalty programs;
- send you promotional marketing material about Company company and partners;
- produce content for our activity feed feature;
- customize, analyze, adjust and improve the Service to better meet your needs;
- execute a sweepstakes, contest or other promotion;
- enforce Company agreements with you;
- provide you with important administrative information regarding the Service, such as changes to this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use, rewards and loyalty programs and other policies;
- · prevent fraud and other prohibited or illegal activities; and
- comply with potential requests of law enforcement or data protection agencies.

When possible, Online Information may be combined and/or linked to other Personal Information that you provided to us, in accordance with the purposes specified above.

We may use your deidentified Personal Information and Online Information to prepare anonymized, aggregated data about our users ("Anonymized Data"). We may provide third parties with Anonymized Data in describing the Service to prospective partners, advertisers and other third parties, and for all other lawful purposes. As communicated to third parties, the Anonymized Data does not include any information permitting the recipient to identify, locate or contact you.

Third Party Service Providers

Company employs other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf, such as fulfilling orders, delivering packages, sending postal mail and e-mail, serving ads on our behalf, providing search results and links, and processing credit card payments. These third-party service providers have access to Personal Information needed to perform their functions but may not use it for any other purpose.
